Will help you understand the regional process to prepare your project for ARC and EDA grant funding consideration

Federal ARC and EDA grant funding for projects is becoming more and more competitive. Each year, the Northern Tier Regional Planning and Development Commission goes through a project prioritization process to identify projects for possible funding in Bradford, Sullivan, Susquehanna, Tioga, and Wyoming Counties. There is very limited funding for few projects, so this is an effort to find the best projects to benefit our region.

This workshop is designed for **IDA's, IDC's, Municipal Authorities, Local Governments, and other Non-Profit Organizations** in developing a project scope that meets eligibility requirements and to help you through the application process for grants from the Appalachian Regional Commission and Economic Development Administration. The workshop will help you understand the application process, performance measures, basic federal forms, project timeline, matching fund requirements, approval process, and more.
