The Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development's (DCED) Educational Improvement Tax Credit Program (EITC) is designed to award tax credits to businesses who donate money, equipment and/or services to our public school districts through local Educational Improvement Organizations.

Educational Applicant Guidelines

Programs that work to support the School-to-Work and Career Development programs within the three Tioga County school districts: Northern Tioga School District, Southern Tioga School District and Wellsboro Area School District, are eligible to submit an application to the ***Tioga County Foundation*** for funding consideration. Applications can be obtained from the foundation.
